Buy candy in eco-friendly packaging

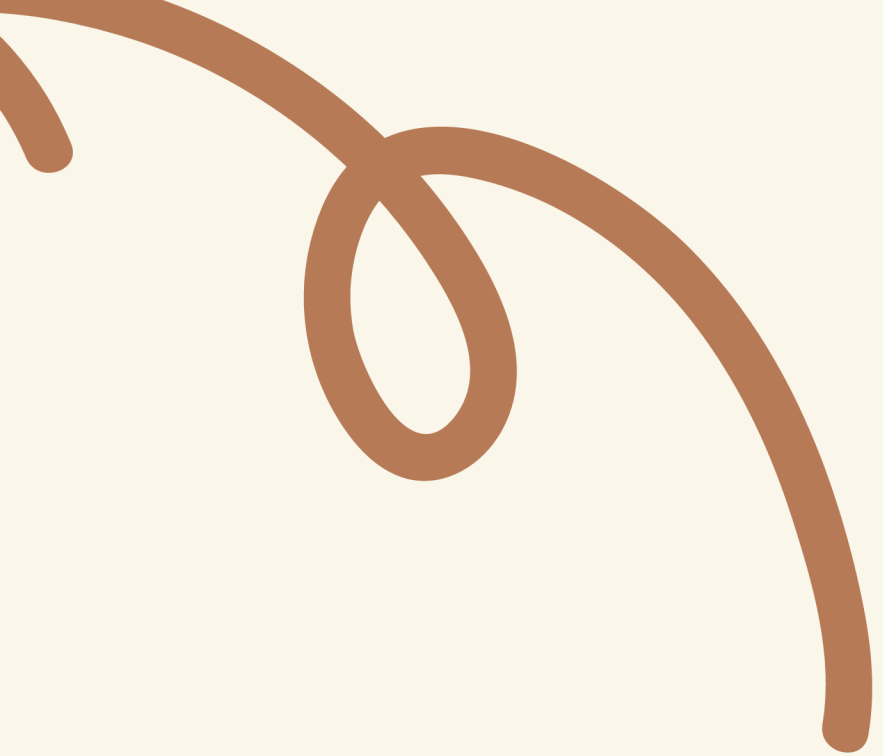
02.
